During the 2017-2018 season, influenza-like-illness (ILI) activity began to increase in November, reaching an extended period of high activity during January and February nationally, and remained elevated through the end of March. ILI peaked at 7.5%, the highest percentage since the 2009 flu pandemic, which peaked at 7.7%.

Impact. The higher level of activity in the community this year has led to higher levels of absenteeism. Additionally, people in the community with ILI have been slightly more inclined to seek health advice from a GP than in recent years. In 2017, the peak 8 weeks of FluTracking ILI activity, 16.5% of participants reported fever, cough and absence from normal duties compared with the 5 year average of 13% (Figure 2).1.

During the 2017-2018 season, 979 (93.9 per 100,000 population) influenza-associated hospitalizations were reported to public health. The highest rate of hospitalization was among adults aged ≥ 65 years (Figure 3).
