When the Cleveland Clinic Health System (CCHS) hospitals formed a unified Nursing Institute, one of the first initiatives was to develop a professional practice model (PPM) that encompassed the combined culture and history of the system-wide nursing practice philosophy and values. The Cleveland Clinic Nursing Institute's PPM was developed in 2009 by a committee of Cleveland Clinic nurses in an effort to align and integrate nursing practice with the mission, vision and values.

The Stanford Health Care (SHC) Professional Practice (PPM) represents a framework for nursing excellence and is a unique depiction of all the key components of nursing practice at SHC. It represents nursing practice across every setting: inpatient, outpatient, and interventional care venues.

The Life Perspective Rhythm Model includes the concepts of nursing, person, health, and environment. The model contributes to nursing knowledge by providing taxonomy for identifying and labeling nursing concepts. In this model, health is identified as a basic human dimension in continuous development.
