In a permaculture garden plants are grouped into seven distinct 'layers'. The canopy is the tallest layer, and usually consists of tall trees. The understory includes smaller trees and large shrubs, followed by the shrub layer, which can include fruit bushes such as blueberries and gooseberries.

Permaculture gardens use as much as possible to increase their yields and have little waste. Kitchen and garden waste is composted which is then spread on the garden beds providing essential nutrients and microorganisms to the garden.
